- Submit an official transcript bearing the school's seal and placed in an envelope secured by the official school stamp over the sealed flap
- Submit a small picture labeled with name on the back must be included

Packet should include:

- (1) Completed application (2) Transcript (3) Picture
- (4)1 letter of recommendation (5) Typed essay

Applications will be accepted between August 11, 2019 – September 30, 2019

Applications must be mailed no later than September 30, 2019. Late or incomplete applications will not be reviewed.
